Just as diners pair food and wine, a new program is pairing wineries and farms with RVers. Harvest Hosts — a nationwide network of vintners, farmers, growers and producers — invite RVers to visit their vineyards and farms and allow them to dry camp overnight free of charge. Harvest Hosts is the first membership program of its kind in the United States. RVers pay a \$20 annual membership fee (a discounted rate for the 2010 founding year).
